

# Fees Information 2009

The following fees are given as an indication for students enrolling in 2009. Final determination of fees will be made in term four and will be advised in a mail out to families sent in January.

## **Resource Fee**

\$140 per year. This fee is a voluntary donation and is used to benefit all students both in and outside the classroom. Our special character activities are not funded by the government and we rely on this fee to fund them. The funds are used for chaplaincy services, religious education, the school magazine, the library, needy student assistance, subsidies and other activities in the school as decided from time to time by the Board of Trustees. An account is enclosed and payment is to be made to the College. The resource fee qualifies for a tax rebate and receipts are issued at the time of payment. Payment can also be made by installment by completing the enclosed AP form and taking it to your bank.

## **ID card and the School Diary**

\$7.00 ID card. Compulsory for all students.  
\$3.00 SBC school diary. Compulsory for all students.

## **Sports Fees**

Our sports fee is \$40 and will allow a student to register for as many sports as he chooses with the exception of extra charges of \$20 for cricket, \$20 for basketball and \$50 for hockey. Participants in some sports may be required to provide their own equipment or attire. The sports fee deadline is Friday 6 March. Students will not be allowed to register for sports unless the fee is paid.

## **Curriculum Fees**

Compulsory for all students taking those subjects. Itemised on attached sheet and invoiced early in Term 1.

## **NZQA Fees (unconfirmed)**

National Qualifications Framework \$75 for NZ students, \$375 for international students. Considerable reductions are available for NZ families who qualify for financial assistance that meet at least one of the following criteria (benefit-based, income-based, multiple candidate applications). Confirmed NZQA fees each year will be advised and are payable in Term 2.

## **Education outside the classroom Y7-10**

Compulsory for all participating students\*.  
\$40 for Years 7 to 10 alternative programme payable by October.

## **Retreat Fees**

Compulsory for all participating students.  
\$15 Years 7 – 12, \$45 Year 13

## **Catholic Schools Board Attendance Dues**

\$334 per year for students in Years 7 – 8 \$650 per year for students in Years 9 – 13  
Compulsory for all students\*. Accounts are sent out each term from the Catholic Schools Board Office. Please pay Catholic Schools Board directly, do not pay these dues to St Bernard's College.

## **Online Learning Management System**

We will be providing access to an online learning environment in 2009. We anticipate a cost of \$12 per student. Further details will be provided when available.
