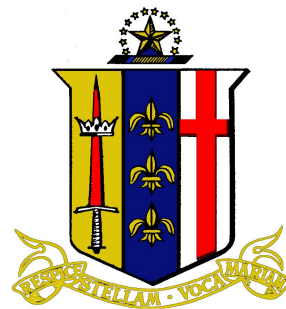

FOREIGN FEE PAYING STUDENTS

Fees Information for 2011-2012 School Year

All figures are quoted in NZ\$ and include GST)

TUITION FEES: NZ\$12,000 per year.

Payment must be made in advance for the whole year's tuition. The fee covers tuition and other costs associated with the learning programme (e.g. field trips, sport fees) A non-refundable application fee of NZ\$250 applies. Refunds may be made at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.

N.B. NCEA examinations incur an extra fee

ADDITIONAL LIVING COSTS: These additional living costs generally relate to school stationery as well as the purchase of personal items. An allowance of NZ\$60 per week would normally be sufficient.

MEDICAL INSURANCE: This is compulsory and can be arranged by the College. The premium for 12 months is approximately NZ\$650.

UNIFORM: This must be worn by all students. The cost of a complete uniform is about NZ\$700, including blazer.

ACCOMMODATION: The College can arrange homestay accommodation for NZ\$210 per week. This includes full board. A non-refundable homestay placement application fee of NZ\$250 applies.

The above fees must be paid on the acceptance of enrolment, before an offer of a place can be made.

Uniform:	NZ\$700 (approx)
Medical insurance:	NZ\$650 (approx)
Living allowance:	NZ\$ 60 per week
