In return for ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE finding and supervising a homestay for _____

- 1) I guarantee the good behaviour of the student in New Zealand. I understand that unacceptable behaviour on the part of the student in homestay may lead to termination of the student's enrolment at ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE.
- 2) I undertake to pay NZ\$250 homestay placement fee to ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE and NZ\$210 a week (16 weeks in advance, including 2 weeks holidays) to ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE to cover board payments. ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE will make payments to the homestay. I include NZ\$3610 with this application.
- 3) I understand that the student may not make any national or international telephone calls from the homestay premises unless the charges are reversed. If any such calls are made I guarantee to re-imburse the homestay for any costs. A student may have his own line with permission from the homestay.
- 4) I undertake that the student will not leave the homestay without the consent of the homestay co-ordinator and, if the student is under 21 years of age the permission of the homestay co-ordinator.
- 5) I undertake that the students will give at least two weeks notice before leaving the homestay. If no notice is given the full boarding fee has to be paid.
- 6) I accept that homestay accommodation does not allow my son to own or drive a motor vehicle while he is enrolled as a student at ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE.
- 7) I understand that, in the event of the student's not coming to New Zealand, ST BERNARD'S COLLEGE will retain the NZ\$200 placement fee. The advance board payments will be refunded in full, although if there is less than two weeks' notice given, the College will deduct a sum to compensate the homestay for inconvenience experienced or expenses incurred in anticipation of the student's arrival.
